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Yes. The [Structured Abstract](#) [1] is intended to streamline, clarify and make more explicit ACCME's expectations for verifying Performance-in-Practice. Using the fill-form fields on the structured abstract, the provider should state information representative of the entire series. It is permissible for the provider to summarize, or abstract, information from multiple sessions into brief statements on the abstract document.
